3. Values and Intentions (Getting Real without Getting Too Deep)

Man:

On a more serious note—what do you value most in relationships?

Woman:

Honesty, humor, and emotional safety. You?

Man:

Authenticity and communication. I love a woman who knows how to express what she wants without games.

Woman:

Exactly. Games are for toddlers and PlayStations.

Man:

🤣 I might steal that line.

Okay, let's flip it: what's a green flag for you in someone you're dating?

Man:
